Volunteer Role:

Special training provided for: Green Teams (done day of, onsite), Lead Prep teams (done day of, onsite), House Captains, Logistic Captains

Minimum Age (i.e., kids allowed?) No one under the age of 14 may be on a worksite. We prefer that LC's and HC's be at least college aged.
