### BIBLE DISCUSSION

1. Read Genesis 39:1-23, what stood out to you? What did you notice for the first time?
2. What values did Joseph demonstrate?
3. Read Genesis 37:2-10. How has Joseph changed from last week's teenage Joseph to this week's Joseph?

### LIFE APPLICATION

4. When you hear the word "integrity," who comes to mind? What does the word integrity mean to you?
5. Have you ever been in a situation that challenged your integrity? Explain.
6. For Joseph, being faithful became a habit, a way of living -- one "next right thing" at a time. What are some ways that our incremental choices lead to big choices?
7. Is there somewhere in your life where you could make incremental changes/choices this week? What's something that you can do right now?

### CHALLENGE

Spend some time this week thinking about how integrity affects every aspect of our lives. Integrity isn't just not doing bad things; it can also be actively seeking out good things to do. What are some ways you could act with anticipatory integrity this week?
