SERIES BIG IDEA

Jesus ushered in a radical way of living where we can enjoy God.

MESSAGE BIG IDEA

Jesus ushered in a radical way of living where everyone belongs.

SCRIPTURE: LUKE 14

ICEBREAKER AND OPENING THOUGHT

Use this time to open your group and break the ice. The second question is designed to help groups become more comfortable with the topic of the day and to engage each other.

BIBLE DISCUSSION

Read the scripture out loud and allow your group time to think through the questions. Luke 14 is a passage that covers a few different parables and stories around our topic of radical inclusion. Take time to go through the first half then the second half to think through how radical Jesus' calling actually is.

APPLICATION

Start by reading the NT Wright quote, ask the question, then read the quote again. Allow people to have time to process their answers. Studies show that people need on average ten to twelve seconds to answer a question, but we as moderators typically only allow three to five seconds before we get uncomfortable.

Remember, these are simple questions, yet could have complex responses. Let your group walk through them slowly.

CHALLENGE

Spend time as a small group talking about constructive and practical ways you can begin to incorporate this radical upside-down life this week. Pray for each other in pairs or smaller groups.
