## DAY 1

### Read Psalm 119:160

This month is all about knowledge, learning something new so you can be better at whatever you do. You're already good at this! Every day at school you're learning all kinds of new cool things. Grab a sheet of paper and write down something new you learned this week.

All that learning will help you for sure. But there is something even more important than letters and numbers. God wants us to grow in your knowledge of Him. That's why God sent Jesus, the Son of God, to show us what's true.

### Read John 14:6

#### One Way

### Read John 8:31-32

You learn new things every day. But all that learning should include focusing on what's true. And how do we know what's true? By looking to Jesus. We can read his words in the Bible. What Jesus had to say changed everything about how people relate to God and the people around them. The way you can know what's true is by doing what Jesus says.

### Read John 1:14

#### Add It Up

But did you know the answer could be 100? Here's why!

When Jesus came to earth as a baby, He was 100% God. But on that night in the little town of Bethlehem, Jesus entered the world as a baby, 100% human.

100% HUMAN + 100% GOD = JESUS

Jesus walked and talked, ate and slept, felt anger and surprise, lived and died so that we could be forgiven. When Jesus came to earth to show us the way to God, He was full of grace and truth.

100% GRACE + 100% TRUTH = JESUS

When we see how loving and kind and amazing Jesus is, we understand why we should follow Jesus. He is also forgiving and willing to give us a second chance when we mess up. And while the math might not add up the way we think it should, Jesus is the one worth following as we grow in knowledge each day.

## DAY 1

### Read Proverbs 9:10

### Read Proverbs 3:21-22

King Solomon was one of the wisest people to ever live. God inspired him to write down the wisdom he learned throughout his life. A lot of those wise sayings are included in the Book of Proverbs. If you want to know how God wants you to live, Proverbs is a great place to start!

But wisdom is more than just knowing the right thing to do. Wisdom is remembering what is true and then putting that truth in to practice. Like Solomon says in the verse, when we hold on to that wisdom and practice it, it can be like a beautiful necklace around our necks.



#### Remembering Wisdom

Grab an index card. Write out your favorite verse on the card and stick it in a place where you get ready in the morning. As you're getting ready for the day, read the verse. At the end of the week, think about how you put that verse into practice.
