Opening Questions

- If someone gave you \$10,000, how would you spend it?
- 2. What personal assessments have you taken, and what have you learned about yourself? Some examples are Myers-Briggs, the Enneagram and Spiritual Gifts Tests

Bible Discussion

- 3. What does Psalm 139:13-14 teach us about the nature and character of God? How does the imagery of knitting used in this passage deepen our understanding of God's involvement in our creation?
- 4. What does it mean to you personally to be "fearfully and wonderfully made" by God?
