Scripture

2 Corinthians 9:6-8

Opening Questions

1. What gift have you received that you will always treasure?
2. Generosity has the power to turn the world upside down. In what ways, large or small, have you seen generosity make a difference in the life of a person, family or community?

Bible Discussion

3. Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-8. How would you put this passage into your own words?
4. According to verse 8, what does Paul say about God's ability to provide abundantly for all our needs? How does this encourage us to trust in God's provision?

Life Application
