### **GOAL OF SMALL GROUP**

To show students what it means to live the full life Jesus is inviting us into by stepping out of isolation and welcoming the life of community that Jesus intends for us.

- 4. Read Mark 5:18-20. What does this part of the story say about Jesus? What does it say about how Jesus has a better way for us when we are isolated?
- 5. What is a way you can create meaningful community and relationships starting here at camp?
- 6. What are some fears you have that may keep you from being in community and friendship?
- 7. Find a partner in your cabin, preferably someone you do not know so well. Spend some time praying with your partner and asking God to help each other step out of isolation and into a Godly community.
